APGOPO Summer Assignment 2017-2018

Your assignment will be to read, listen to, and/or watch the major news stories related to the federal government throughout the summer, and participate in multiple online discussions via Padlet. There will also be an open note current events quiz the first week of school.

Padlet Discussions

After reading/listening/watching the major federal (not state/local) news stories, participate in at least <u>FOUR</u> online discussions from the eight weeks listed in the table below by posting questions and/or comments on the appropriate Padlet discussion page. Each Padlet discussion will be posted on my website and I'll also send each of you direct links. You can discuss any news stories as long as they relate to the *federal* government and political system.

Examples (these are not exhaustive lists):

<u>Acceptable</u>: major Supreme Court decisions, anything related to the Trump presidency, U.S. foreign policy with North Korea, Syria, etc.

<u>Unacceptable</u>: contract dispute between Ripon teachers and Ripon Unified School district, increases in California's gas tax, etc.

- You must be signed in to your RUSD Gmail account while participating in the Padlet discussions.
- All questions on the current events quiz will be created from content from all Padlet discussions, so be sure to read the questions/comments from each of them even though you're only required to participate in four of the discussions.
- You may take handwritten notes throughout the summer as you watch and discuss the news, which may be used during the current events quiz the first week of school. Keep in mind that the quiz will be timed, so excessive note-taking may be counterproductive.
- As you read/listen/watch/discuss the news, start developing opinions on the issues facing our country -- **DO NOT** become overwhelmed if you don't fully understand everything at first, as you will develop a deeper understanding over time.
